I hope you are well and have enjoyed the summer. While in the south of France we have had very hot weather, in many areas in Ethiopia it has been raining and very cold since June ! This usually continues until mid October.

### Alelu 3

In June we finished our third classroom block (4 classrooms and staff room) for Alelu Primary School (photos 1,2) !

### Shama Laka Primary School

Continuing construction of a 4-classroom block and a lab/library block for Shama Laka Primary School. There has been a delay due to heavy rain and the need to cut trees threatening to fall on the classroom block (photo 3).

### Classroom block construction further south

H.E.L.P. has finished all constructions under way further south of Shama Laka, BUT we have new projects for Autumn 2018.... Please read further on.

### Student lunches

Lunches in two Addis Ababa schools continued until the end of the school year in June.

### Shama Laka Primary School

We would like to build a second classroom block, to replace one of the very run down ones (photo 4). Budget price : € 22,000. We would also like to build a teachers' center where teachers and the community could meet and work.

## Aleltu Primary School

The school and community have asked us to build a laboratory/library block because they have neither. Budget price : € 42,000.

## Aleltu Kindergarten

In 2016 HELP finished construction of a 3-block kindergarten for Aleltu. We then supplied desks and other school furniture (photos 5,6). We would now like to donate educational and leisure equipment (books, educational toys, swings, balls, etc.) that children this age need in order to develop. We would purchase this equipment in Ethiopia for better prices.

## Kako Sellé Primary School : classroom block construction

Kako Sellé is located in southern Ethiopia, near the town of Jinka. H.E.L.P. has built several classroom blocks for this region. Now we have been asked to build a 4-classroom block for this school because the existing blocks are so run down (photos 7,8). Budget price : € 20,000.

## Zere Kofé Primary School : classroom block construction

H.E.L.P. has already built two classroom blocks for this school, located in the same area as Kako Sellé. These constructions enabled the school to open 5th and 6th grade classes, and tripled attendance in the other grades! As a result, classes are overcrowded and there are not enough student desks (photos 9,10). We would, therefore, like to build a third classroom block and supply desks. Construction budget price : € 20,000.

**H.E.L.P. is looking for donations in order to carry out the above projects.** Founded in 2008, in the past seven years HELP has built 21 blocks (classrooms, laboratory, library, administrative), 2 latrine blocks, one cantine and one resting room for 11 Ethiopian schools. We deeply thank all our donors who have made this possible !

We have seen that, as a result, these constructions motivate :

- parents to send their children to school regularly,
- students to learn in suitable conditions,
- more children to attend school.

**Wouldn't you like to help us to continue these beneficial activities?** All your donations are useful ! You also contribute to solving the migrant problem, as most educated people do not want to leave their country.
